The architect Christian Kerez, born 1962 in Venezuela lives and works in Zürich. His work is characterized by constant research and development and he continuously tests new themes and forms with models as his principal tools. Following his professional education at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology, ETH, in Zürich he worked as a design architect in the office of Rudolf Fontana. After extensive published work in the field of architectural photography, he opened his own architectural office in Zürich in 1993.

Christian Kerez has been a visiting professor at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology Zürich since 2001 and was appointed assistant professor in design and architecture in 2003. Furthermore he participated at the last biennale of architecture in Venice.
